Taylor to Run as an Irish-American.

J. B. Taylor, the celebrated colored runner, who has just passed his final examination at the University of Pennsylvania, and the quarter-of-a-mile champion of the Amateur Athletic Union, made two entries yesterday for the Olympic try-outs, which will be decided at Philadelphia on Saturday. Taylor will sport the emblem of the Irish-American Athletic Club in the 400 and 800 metre races, and in the field against him will be the crack runners of the East. Two additional entries were received for the try-outs. J. Gumpelt of the New York A. C., being added to the list of high jumpers, while Homer Heath of the University of Michigan will compete in the running broad jump.
